Amarant

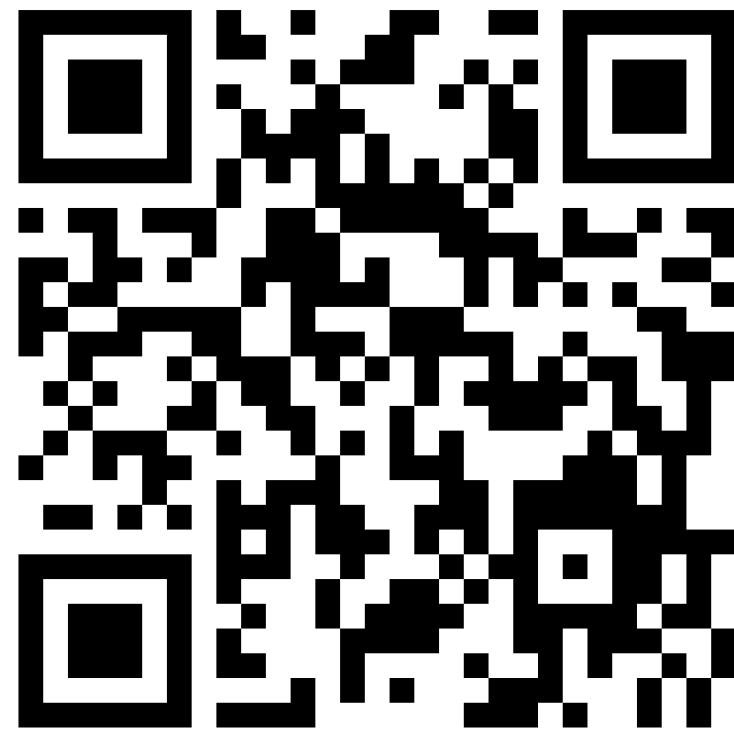

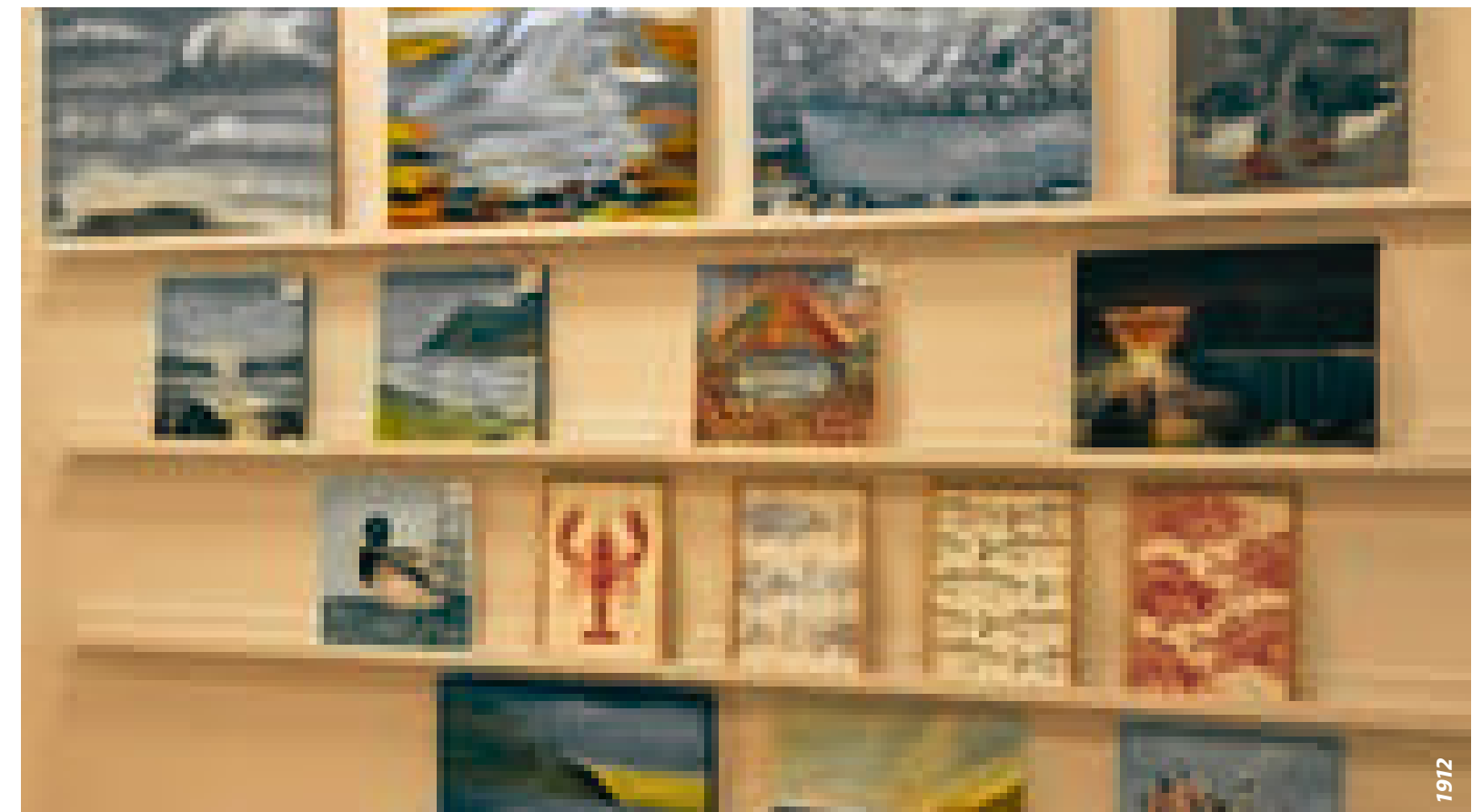

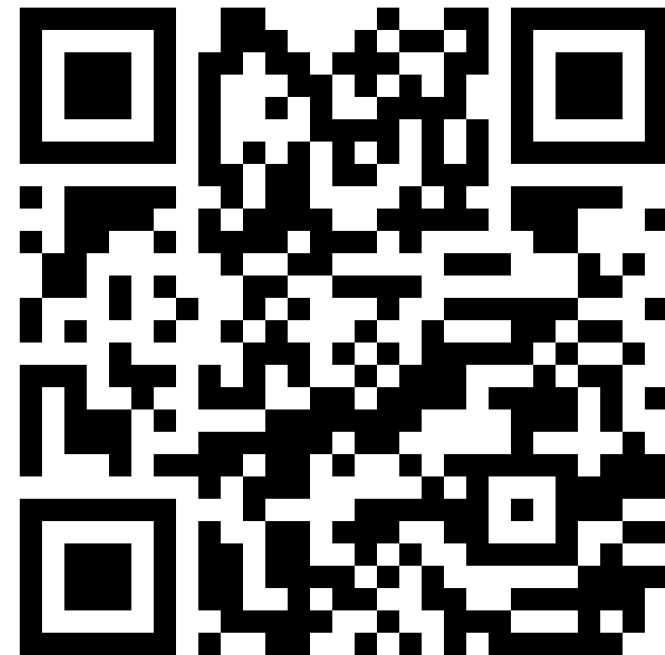
One of the Faroe Islands' top cafés.

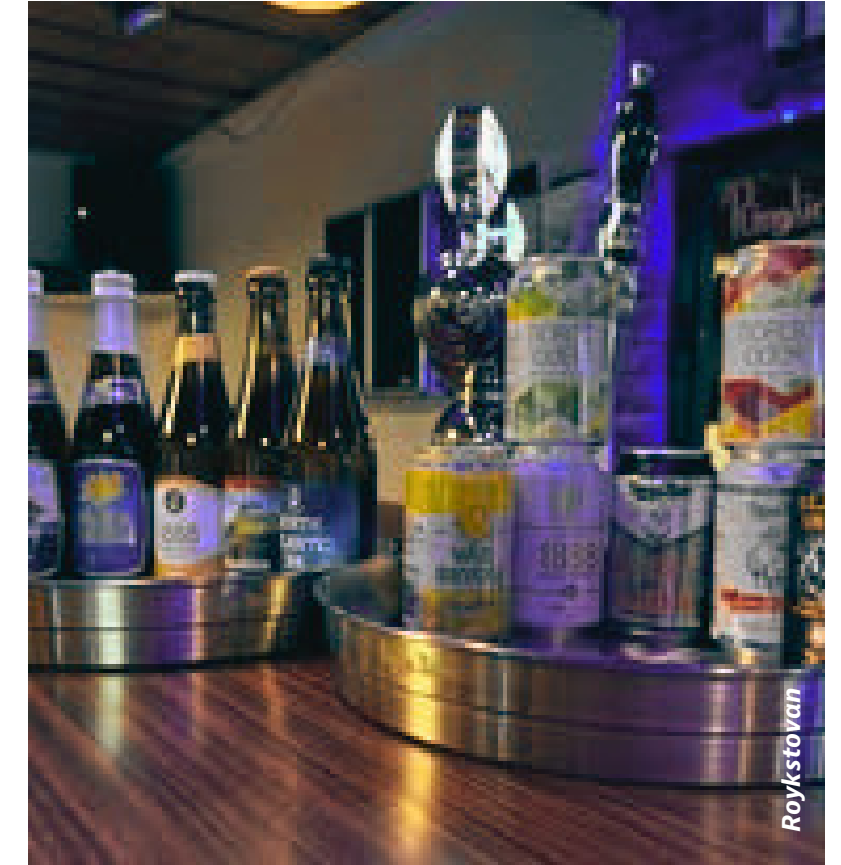

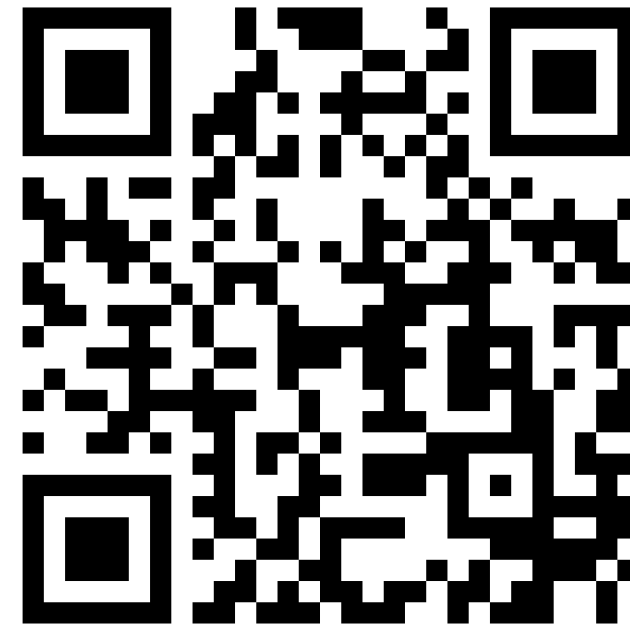
The oldest pubs in Klaksvík and likely one of the oldest in the Faroe Islands.

The pub opened in 1974. Since then, it has become a well-known meeting place for locals and visitors.

Over the years, Roykstovan has built a reputation as a lively spot. People come here to enjoy drinks, music, and good company.

From the beginning, Roykstovan has embraced the atmosphere of what many Danes call a "brunt værtshus". This means a classic pub with character and history.

The atmosphere is relaxed and informal. At the same time, the pub continues to introduce new ideas and activities for its guests.

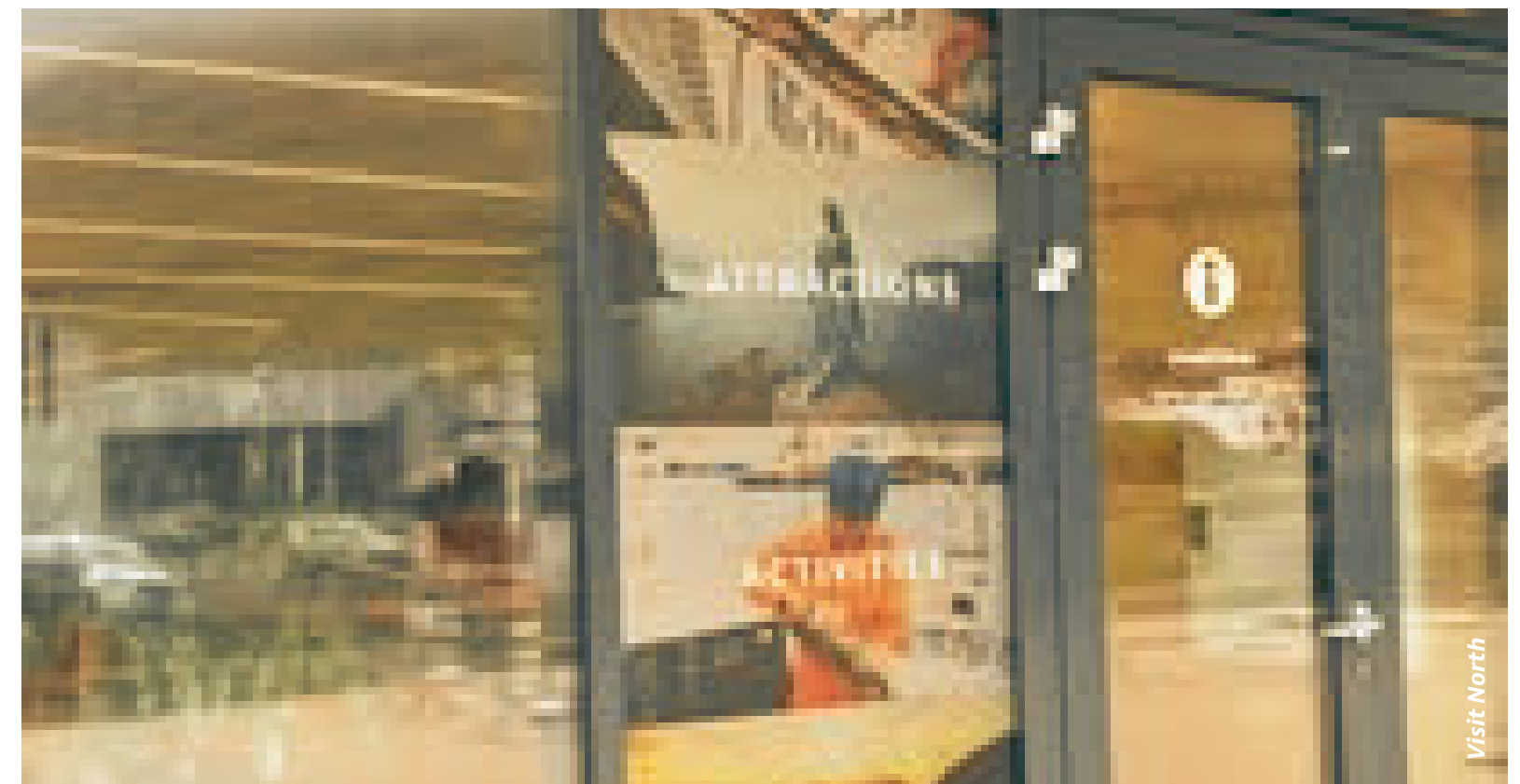

Norðoya Fornminnasavn Klaksvík offers visitors a fascinating journey into everyday Faroese life in earlier centuries. The museum is located in an old shop building that once served as a bustling centre for fishing, trade, labour and export.

Founded in 1968, Norðoya Fornminnasavn's mission is to preserve and share the history of the Norðoyggjar region. The museum collects, maintains and displays artefacts that document daily life, work and community in earlier times.

The museum is run by a private foundation, ensuring that its focus remains locally anchored and culturally meaningful.
